

Purpose

This policy aims to prevent conflicts of interest within Transparency International BElgium (TI Belgium) by ensuring transparency and proper governance in relation to the declaration of interests, the role of the Institut des Réviseurs d'Entreprises (IRE), and the participation of paid staff in decision-making processes.

Institut des Réviseurs d'Entreprises (IRE)

The Institut des Réviseurs d'Entreprises shall abstain from approving TI Belgium's accounts in any instance where it has a potential or perceived conflict of interest. Its role will be limited to auditing, with the approval of accounts being subject to independent review.

Staff Participation in Voting

Paid staff are prohibited in voting in any instant where it has a potential or perceived conflict of interest.

Board Member Recusal

Any Board member with a declared or perceived conflict of interest must recuse themselves from discussions and voting on the matter that gives rise to the conflict.
